- 2. Lapse of A Day or More Between Preparation and Service
- 3. Infected Employee Who Practices Poor Personal Hygiene
- 4. Inadequate Cooking
- 5. Inadequate Hot Storage and Improper Reheating; Use of Leftovers
- 6. Ingesting Raw Contaminated Foods
- 7. Cross-Contamination
- 8. Improper Cleaning of Equipment; Improper Sanitization
- 9. Toxins
- 10. Unsafe Sources
- 11. Poor Storage Practices (Hot or Cold)
